DAY CAMP JULY 9-13

Day Camp will run Monday, Wednesday- Friday from 8:30 am - 3:30 pm. The entire event will be set up exclusively for boys and girls grades 1-3. We will have daily Bible lessons, games, skits, missionary stories, music and crafts.

Breakfast and lunch will be served each morning and afternoon. We are planning a great day of water games and activities. It will be an exciting time for every boy and girl!

WHAT TO BRING

SPECIAL THURSDAY

Thursday will be a different day at the camp. Your child will have the opportunity to go to the pool and stay the night if they so choose. Those campers wishing to stay the night will need a change of clothes, toiletries, a towel, etc. All campers will be going to the pool unless you pick them up before departure (tentatively scheduled at 3:30 PM).

We will plan on being at Coonskin Pool from 4:00-6:00 and will have dinner at the camp around 6:30 with movies and games to follow. If your child is not staying the night they will need to be picked up at the pool at 6:00 PM or at the camp at 3:30 PM. Only campers that are staying the night will return to the camp that evening.

MOM & DAD - PLEASE READ!

We want to insure that everyone gets the most from their camp experience. Camp is a wonderful place to make improvements to your life for the glory of God. We try to accomplish this in a Godly atmosphere that is separated from all the intrusions, temptations and distractions of the normal everyday life.
