CHRISTIAN CONDUCT:

Our camp maintains high standards of Christian conduct. Separate swim times are scheduled for boys and girls. The camp reserves the right to set standards of conduct such as boy/girl relations, dress standards, response to authority, etc. Campers who violate these standards are subject to dismissal at parents' expense.

DRESS STANDARDS:

All clothing must be loose fitting and cover the body from shoulders to the middle of the knee. For recreation - girls and boys may wear loose fitting sports clothes that come to the middle of the knee. For preaching services - boys will wear shirts with collars - girls will wear a skirt or dress. Campers must remove body piercing except girls with pierced ears. The camp reserves the right to require any camper to change their clothing if it is deemed inappropriate.

WHAT TO BRING:
